<u>Connecting Students to College and Careers: ACPSD Partners with STEM Premier</u> and the South Carolina Manufacturers Alliance

The Aiken County Public School District is leveraging partnerships and resources to connect students with high-quality post-secondary opportunities. Aiken County is one of the very first districts to partner with the manufacturing alliance in this initiative.
