

: There will be an for late work; the only exception for that penalty is in cases (medical excuse from doctor/dentist, bereavement, court appearance, of homebound). The following is a breakdown of late work consequences:

- number of days absent to make up an assessment (will be discussed with student upon return to class)
  - for long-term assignments and projects (anything assigned 5+ days in advance)
  - o -20 points for 1 day late (school policy)
  - o -10 additional points for 2 days late (-30 total); projects will be accepted after 2 late days
  - "Selective Incomplete" Classwork (classwork not turned in when due, especially at the end of class period)
    - o -20 points must be turned by class time or WIN time (whichever comes first) of the next day or it will not be accepted at all.
